1	<p>Physical Preparation Students will arrive and perform in proper performance attire as specified in the Disclosure Document and per in-class discussion and instruction.</p> <p>A – fully prepared; every article of uniform correct and ready B – missing one article C – missing two or more articles D – did not wear performance attire</p>	
2	<p>Concert Etiquette Students will behave appropriately while in the audience. The following are considered behavior violations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - talking or whispering while another group is performing (quietly between songs is appropriate) - using a cell phone at any time for any reason while a group is performing - a cell phone making any sound while a group is on stage - cat calling or screaming, even during the applause (except where appropriate, ie Fruitcake) - the violation of any other performance rule or policy (ie, possessing non-performance items beneath robe) <p>A – no behavior violations B – one violation C – two violations D – if somebody had to ask you to stop E – if you embarrass the group</p>	
3	<p>Memorization Students will perform with music fully memorized.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Knowing all the notes and rhythms of the piece of music being performed without relying on those around you. - Knowing the text of the piece and articulating without waiting on those around you. - Knowing all rehearsal markings and following them (breaths, dynamics, cutoffs, etc.) <p>A – fully memorized and confident (one or no memory lapses) B – mostly memorized and confident (two to four memory lapses) C – somewhat memorized and confident (5+ memory lapses) D – hardly competent (large scale memory lapses) E – no idea what's going on</p>	
4	<p>Performance Attendance Students will remain in the auditorium for the entirety of the performance. Excessive bathroom breaks or lingering in the hall, foyer, or side rooms are unacceptable.</p> <p>A – stayed for the whole concert, did not tarry en route or linger outside auditorium B – withdrew from the performance for inappropriate lengths of time C – left early, or withdrew from the entire concert</p>
